Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Kenowa Hills High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact the building principal, Nathan Robrahn, for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the <u>MI School Data Parent Dashboard</u>, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not given any of these labels.

As a school we continue to find ways to assist students in their learning and we do this through our ability to teach students at all levels. This may happen in the classroom, or in our Advisory period or sometimes after school. Our teachers are dedicated to helping all students succeed.

- PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL: Kenowa Hills High School assigns students to its school based on district geographic boundaries. The school also participates in the Kent Intermediate School District schools of choice program, the State of Michigan Section 105c schools of choice program, and Section 6 student transfer process.
- 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN: Kenowa Hills High School participates in the Michigan Department of Education's continuous improvement process. The building has a representative stakeholder group responsible for various school improvement tasks throughout the school year. - 3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL: There are no specialized schools within Kenowa Hills High School. However, the building offers supplemental services for students who qualify for additional support and assistance.
- 4. IDENTIFY HOW TO ACCESS A COPY OF THE CORE CURRICULUM, A DESCRIPTION OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION, AND AN EXPLANATION OF THE VARIANCES FROM THE STATE'S MODEL: Kenowa Hills High School uses the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) and the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC). The CCSS are a set of national standards that aim to allow for more in-depth learning and a focus on skills and competencies demanded in the 21st Century. In this time of transition, learning targets are either aligned to MMC or the CCSS. Copies of grade level or department's curriculum are available in the building's main office.
- 5. - 6. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: During the 2023-24 school year we had 305 or 33% of our students represented at our parent/teacher conferences.
- 7. HIGH SCHOOLS ARE REQUIRED TO ALSO REPORT ON THE FOLLOWING:
 - a. There were 136 student enrolled in post secondary courses (16%)
 - b. The school offers 10 AP courses
 - c. 226 students were enrolled in AP courses for 25%
 - d. 248 AP tests were taken with 51% scoring a 3 or higher
